

Ad hoc announcement pursuant to Section 15 WpHG

PC-WARE: Change from Prime Standard to General Standard

Leipzig, 16 December 2009 - Shares issued by PC-Ware Information Technologies AG (DE0006910904/ WKN 691090) are approved for trading on the regulated market of the Frankfurt Stock Exchange, with simultaneous admission to the section of the regulated market associated with additional follow-up obligations ("Prime Standard"). With the consent of the Supervisory Board, the Management Board of PC-Ware Information Technologies AG has agreed to change the company's exchange listing from the Prime Standard of the regulated market to the General Standard of the regulated market of the Frankfurt Stock Exchange. An application was today made to the Frankfurt Stock Exchange for the revocation of admission of company shares to the Prime Standard.

By changing the listing segment, the company aims to reduce the additional expense associated with Prime Standard listing. The revocation of admission will become effective after three months subsequent to the publication on the Internet of the revocation decision by the management of the stock exchange (www.deutsche-boerse.com). It does not affect the admission of PC-Ware Information Technologies AG shares to the regulated market (General Standard).
